### **Exciting news!** New Online Registration at Camp La Vida!

Camp La Vida<sup>SM</sup> is going all online and cashless starting December 1 for the 2024 summer and beyond. You will

be able to register your group or your children from anywhere with Internet access. Once you create an account, register and pay a deposit or in full though a credit card, debit card or e-check you will get an instant confirmation and can send another parent a cabin mate request for their camper. As time gets closer parents can fill out the other forms online and it will store your information securely, and from year-to-year you just update your information.

Camp La Vida is excited to use our updated registration and camp management system to improve efficiency and effectiveness. Our Bunk1 feature which we have used for the last 10+ summers will be incorporated in this as well. This software will allow us to be cashless at camp which will allow parents to see in real time purchases at camp. When you register your child you will give them spending money for canteen/camp store/offering in an account. The money will be there for them when they make purchases at camp. If you are there for a Mother/Daughter camp or as a volunteer you will be able to put money in the system or use a credit card to purchase items or give offering.

In 1895, an offering was first collected for the work of the Home Mission Board. In 1934, this offering was renamed the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering for Home Missions to honor the work of Annie Armstrong as a tireless advocate for giving, praying, and going to share the gospel of Jesus Christ with those who did not know Him.


SBC churches annually observe the Week of Prayer for North American missions to pray for missionaries, their ministries, and their families. Prayer fuels spiritually sustaining missionaries in places where the gospel is greatly needed but often opposed.

The official date is the first Sunday in March through the second Sunday. This year it is March 3-10, 2024. Your church can choose this date or another time during the Easter season to participate. 

## **Camp La Vida is Now Hiring 2024 Summer Staff**



Summer camp staff members make a difference in the lives of children and youth! Being on staff is hard work but the rewards are many! This year, Camp La Vida is hiring 30 staff. If you, or someone you know, would be interested in spending their summer serving at Camp La Vida, let us know.

Camp staffers serve as cabin leaders, cabin leaders-in-training, lifeguards, and a few other positions. These are residential, paid positions from May 28-July 26 with most weekends off.

Qualifications are: must be a rising college freshman and up, must be a mature Christian, must be an active member of a SBC church, and must have a love for children, youth, and missions.

During each summer camp session, we enlist four to six

volunteers who are skilled as a photographer, parent liaison, canteen/camp store worker, or maintenance worker to serve. Volunteers help in supportive roles so that camp staff can concentrate on our campers. All volunteers help with the setup and cleanup of the dining hall as well. The requirements are to be a Christian, have a desire to serve, and be a member of an SBC church. You cannot serve at the same time your child is at camp.
